Awards

The Apolinario Mabini awards were launched by the Philippine Foundation for the Rehabilitation of the Disabled, Inc. (PFRD) in 1974 on the occasion of its Silver Anniversary. Since then, it is been major biennial program of the PFRD. The 29th Apolinario Mabini Awards was chaired by Mrs. Lourdes dela Llana Pimentel.

The Award was named after one of the country's foremost heroes, Apolinario Mabini, also known as the Sublime Paralytic. His disability was not a hindrance to his creative genius that provided inspiration to the Philippine revolution.



Objectives

- To recognize individuals, groups and agencies that have made outstanding contributions to persons with disabilities.
- To promote wider recognition of disabled persons as self-respecting, self-reliant and productive members of the society.

Awards Categories

A. Persons with Disabilities Filipino of the Year

Nominee shall be a Filipino with Disability who has excelled in his chosen field and served as exemplar to other persons with disability and to the nation.



B. Persons with Disabilities Group of the Year

Given to a group or organization representing Filipino persons with disabilities that has noteworthy achievements in a cultural, educational, vocational, spiritual, athletic, economic endeavor that has led to positive community impact.



C. Employer of the Year

Given to recognize the employers who demonstrates leadership in providing and encouraging workplace opportunities by hiring, employing and promoting Persons with Disabilities.



D. FriendlyEstablishment of the Year

Given to a friendly establishment or building/facilities, wherein tha main function of the establishment, must be fully accessible to Persons with Disabilites, including compliance to all architectural features and facilities within the common areas, as provided to the general public.





E. Website Accessibility of the Year

Nominee shall have designed and instituted a website that is easily accessible to and in service of persons with various disabilities (visually-impaired, orthopedically-impaired, etc.) for whom more opportunities for growth have been presented and whose communication skills were enhanced accordingly.





F. Local Government Unit of the Year

Given to a local government unit (LGU) which has rendered exceptional services to a significant number of citizens with disabilities within its jurisdiction in the last two years.





G. Rehabilitation Volunteer of the Year

Given to a volunteer Filipino individual and /or that has for the past two years supported Filipino Persons with Disabilities, their families and organizations through care/service provision, advocacy, social action, community development, legal action and related services without receiving compensation.





H. Media Advocate of the Year

Given to a media person, media company or a media program who has consistently advocated for the rights, issues and stories of Persons with Disabilities via the media (broadcast, print, social, allied media.)



Special Awards

For the individual/Group/Organization who has constantly exceptional contributions to the sector of Persons with Disabilities in the last five years.

Nominating Procedures for All Categories

Any recognized institution in the public or private sector can submit a nomination in any of the categories. The nomination should be endorsed by a high official of that institution.

Any individual can submit a nomination in any of the categories.

Former nominees who have not won an award may again be nominated.

Nomination forms, which are available from the PFRD, shall accomplished properly and submitted with all the supporting papers, documents, certificates, etc. together with three(3) postcard-size, full view, glossy black-andwhite photographs of the nominee.

Two sets of properly accomplished nomination forms with the required supporting documents shall be submitted to the PFRD Office, Suite 27, The Columbia Tower, Ortigas Ave., Mandaluyong City no later than March 31, 2020.
