- 2. Acknowledged by his or her peers in the disability movement.
- 3. Knowledge and expertise on issues and concerns of persons with disabilities both in the domestic and global realities.
- 4. Adherence to and promotion of the UNCRPD and other human rights principles.
- 5. No record (documented) of serious ethical/moral or human rights impropriety.
